Learn about pulse, rhythm and pitch?

Use suffixes and prefixes?

Link ideas across paragraphs using adverbials of time, place and number?  
Assess the effectiveness of our own and others' writing?

Name different countries in French?

Read a range of age appropriate texts?  
Check that a book makes sense to us?  
Ask questions to improve our understanding?  
Infer feelings from actions?

Create sketch books to record observations and use them to review and revisit idea?  
Create our own art in the style of the famous artists Pollock and Warhol?

### As mathematicians can we...?

Read, write and order numbers up to 1000 000?  
Round any number up to 1 000 000?  
Count forwards and backwards in steps of powers of 10?  
Interpret negative numbers?  
Round whole numbers and decimals?  
Read Roman numerals up to 1000 (M)?  
Add large numbers in different contexts using formal column addition?  
Use rounding to estimate and check answers to a calculation?
