


Does your child have a Special Educational Need?

Things are changing for children and young people with Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND)!

Make sure you understand important changes that the Children and Families Act (2014) has introduced to the SEND system. Bromley Mencap has an Independent Support service for parents and young people. The service is **FREE** and is run in partnership with Burgess Autistic Trust, Bromley Parent Voice and Expert by Experience.

Independent Support Workers provide independent information and time-limited **support** for parents and young people. In addition they also:

- provide information on the EHC process
- support you to write section A of the EHC Plan
- attend meetings with you and take notes on your behalf
- help you review your plan to ensure it captures all that is needed



- If your child is transferring from a Statement to an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHC Plan) or **changing** to a Pupil Resource Agreement
- ❖ If you are **applying** for a new EHC Plan or
- If your child has got a Learning Difficulty Assessment
