Reading at home

- Pupils are expected to read a school reading book to an adult at least 3 times a week. Books can be changed as needed by putting it in the box outside the classroom at the start of the day.
- Parent/carer should initial and date each time the child reads. If parents/carers would like to, they can comment on their child's reading. This might include words that they decoded using phonics or unfamiliar words that they found tricky to read.
- Regular acknowledgement of the reading completed at home from staff in the form of comments, stickers, stamps or initials. Pupils will also be rewarded for their effort through the behaviour track in their classroom.
