Careers and Aspirations Day, Friday 25th February 2022 'Reach for the Stars'

On Friday 25th February we will be holding our first Careers and Aspirations day at Biggin Hill Primary School.

Our theme for the day is 'Reach for the Stars' as we want all children within our school to feel empowered by the world of opportunities that await. We feel it is very important to raise the aspirations of our children and provide an 'off curriculum' day that will enable the children to find out more about the wide range of careers that are available to them in the future. We aim to deliver an informative and fun day, introducing children to a broad and balanced range of careers and future job prospects - *this is where we need your help!*

In KS1, children will enjoy guest speakers, class activities and think bubble exercises. Each year group will also make an 'Our Aspirations' book where learning experiences are shared.

To make our Careers Fair as interactive as we can for the children, we would like volunteers who participate in our careers fair to make a small tabletop display board about your career/job and bring this with you - we will provide boards to volunteers before half term. The boards can really be as simple or creative as you wish; they are a way of visually illustrating what each career entails. We can always help you if you need some ideas, so please don't let this put you off!
