



MESSAGE FROM MRS FREEMAN

Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been a very cold, but very productive start to 2024 - the children have come back full of energy and ready to learn!

I wanted to provide a staffing update. We have recently appointed some new members of staff and this may seem strange or even unfair given that at the end of last year we went through a redundancy process. I wanted to provide some clarity around this. We have indeed appointed two new LSAs, Ms Taphouse and Ms Withams, but they have been appointed on 1:1 contracts to support children with additional needs; the hours that they have been appointed to work are split between children who have EHCPs. These contracts are not the same as regular LSA contracts and are attached to funding received for individual children and therefore they have not replaced those staff who opted for voluntary redundancy at the end of last year. We have also appointed Ms Taft to work in the dinner hall - this was necessary due to the significant increase in children opting for school dinners. Unfortunately Ms Gardner, who went on maternity leave last year, has decided not to return to work and therefore we have appointed Ms Santos as an apprentice LSA. I hope that this clarifies the the current staffing situation.

Unfortunately Mrs Ellerby is unable to return to work at the moment on the grounds of ill health. We hope that she will be able to return after half term but have emailed Year 2 parents and carers about cover arrangements for Emberley class until Mrs Ellerby is well enough to return.
