



MESSAGE FROM MRS FREEMAN

Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy New Year!

A warm welcome back to school to all our children and families - we hope you all had a marvellous Christmas and had the opportunity to see family and friends. The children have returned well and are very happy and settled.

I am also delighted to welcome Mrs Mason, Aspire Lead, back to school after a period of absence. Mrs Mason will be initially joining us on a phased return.

On Thursday we held our last set tour for families with children due to start Reception in 2023. Our BHPS open events, which were held in November 2022, and our set tours have been very well attended. It is always a pleasure to welcome prospective families to our school - our children have shown the most amazing behaviour for learning during these tours and our visitors have commented on the excellent behaviour and politeness of our children. These first impressions are very important for us as a school and the children have **ALL** helped to show what a wonderful school we are - please do thank them! The national closing date for applications for children due to start school in September 2023 is **15 January 2023**.

Towards the end of last term, I sent a consultation letter for both our proposed timings of the school day (from September 2023) and our draft school uniform policy. Both of these consultations close on 13th January. If you would like to provide your feedback and have not already done so, please do so by completing the following:

Consultation - Timings of the school day

The government has announced that by September 2023, all schools MUST deliver a school week that is a minimum of 32.5 hours. We are consulting on 4 options for the timing of the school day:

- 8.45-3.15 (gates open for soft drop between 8.30 and 8.40am, registers closed at 8.45 am)
- 8.50-3.20 (gates open for soft drop between 8.35 and 8.45am, registers closed at 8.50am)
- 8.55-3.25 (gates open for soft drop between 8.40 and 8.50am, registers closed at 8.55am)
- 9.00-3.30 (gates open for soft drop between 8.45 and 8.55, registers closed at 9am)

Please complete the previously sent Google form to indicate how you would prefer the school day to be adjusted.

Consultation - School Uniform

We have drafted a new school uniform policy which is available in draft format on our school website and we would like to seek your views on this. We have removed all expectations for branded items with the exception of the school tie, though a logoed cardigan or jumper is preferred.

The only significant change that we are proposing is the phased introduction of black PE shorts rather than white, as we feel that white PE shorts are impractical.
