We have introduced a new reading programme in KS2 - "Destination Reader". The programme develops learning behaviours and strategies necessary to become a confident and independent reader.



Dame Rachel de Souza (Children's Comissioner) has launched a new survey -*The Big Ambition*. The survey is aimed at gathering information from children and young people about their schools, communities, family life and the wider world, as well as their hopes, dreams and aspirations for the future. This survey is for all children and young people aged 0 to 18. Children aged 6 to 18 can complete the survey themselves. Friends AGM




Crime at BHPS!!!!
