Thank you to all of the parents and carers who have emailed to share their child's achievements with us - we love to hear about successes outside of school! We have quite a few to publish and so if your child's success does not feature in this edition - watch this space as it will feature very soon!

Swimming Success - Edward S has recently had some great achievements in the sport of swimming. He swims for Bromley Swimming Club, which has around 400 members. Edward was selected to be part of 30 strong team to compete in the National Arena League, which is



a national competition that starts each year with around 600 clubs and 20,000 swimmers. During 2023 there were several rounds of competition between clubs in each region, then based on points the top 20 clubs go through to a National final in Cardiff in March. Despite being a year out of his particular age group, Edward did the club proud, competing in every round and in the final helped the team in two relay races, alongside some of the very best swimmers in the country. Also on an individual level Edward qualified for and competed in the 2024 Kent County Swimming Championships held at the London Aquatic Centre in Stratford. Edward raced in seven events and came away with seven medals. Five Finalist medals (top 8) and two Bronze medals in the 50m Freestyle and 100m Breaststroke. WOW!!!!!
