Reception and Year 1 - Parent/Carer Early Reading workshop, Monday 25th November 2024 from 8:45am to 9:30am

We would like to invite all parents and carers of Reception and Year 1 to an Early Reading workshop on **Monday**, **25th November 2024** from **8:45am to 9:30am**.

Drop off will take place as normal and then parents/carers are invited to the KS1 hall to hear a short presentation on the importance of phonics and how we teach it at Biggin Hill Primary. Next parents/carers will join their children in their classrooms to take part in a demonstration phonics lesson with their child's class teacher. Parents/Carers will sit with their children and work with their child on the activities on offer. We feel this is a really practical way for you to see how we teach phonics and how you can further help your child at home.
