Red noses will be handed out to children in school on 18th March for them to wear for Red Nose Day. If we have any remaining noses, there may be an opportunity for children to purchase these in school on the day, however this is not guaranteed and will depend on supply. Dressing Up

For Red Nose Day, children are invited to wear their own clothes and take part in crazy hair day. We will be collecting donations on the gate as children come into school and teachers will be taking donations in classrooms. Our suggested donation is £1.
