## **School Uniform Expectations - September 2021**

Due to the pandemic, we fully understand that it has been very difficult to obtain new school uniform this year. We also understand that as we come to the end of the school year, lots of items of uniform may well be a little small, tired looking or indeed lost!

From the beginning of the next academic year, I would like to set out our uniform expectations for all children at our school and have attached our 'BHPS School Uniform Expectations' to this letter, which I hope provides clarification and also acts as a quick reference guide. Children are all expected to wear a tie, black school shoes (not boots or trainers) and any hair accessories should be in school colours.

All children are expected to attend school in school uniform and arrive at school looking neat and tidy. All Biggin Hill Primary School branded uniform, which is highlighted in grey on the attached document, is available to be purchased from the School Uniform Shop via Parent Pay at: https://app.parentpay.com/ParentPayShop/Uniform/Default.aspx?shopid=881

We sometimes see 'fashion' haircuts, such as tramlines etc and we would politely ask that you do not allow these during term times - these will not be allowed at secondary school either.
