VE Day 80th Anniversary

The 80th VE Day marked the 80th anniversary of Victory in Europe Day, which occurred on 8 May 1945, when World War II ended in Europe. On that day, the Allied forces accepted Nazi Germany's unconditional surrender, ending nearly six years of war in Europe. In 2025, the 80th anniversary is a significant milestone to remember and honour those who lived through the war, especially the soldiers and civilians who contributed to the victory and peace that followed.

During World War II, Biggin Hill played a vital role as one of Britain's most important RAF fighter stations. Its location, just south of London, made it a key part of the country's air defence during the Battle of Britain in 1940. Pilots based at Biggin Hill were among "The Few" who bravely defended the skies against German attacks, flying numerous missions to protect the capital. Despite being heavily bombed, the station remained operational thanks to the incredible resilience of its crews. Today, Biggin Hill stands as a symbol of courage and determination during one of the most challenging times in our history.
