The Queen's Platinum Jubilee 2022 Celebrations -

We are delighted to announce our plans for The Queen's Platinum Jubilee 2022 celebrations and are very much looking forward to marking this occasion on 27th May.

All children are invited to come into school dressed in red, white and blue and to wear a homemade Jubilee hat! Hats can be as elaborate or as simple as you wish and we look forward to seeing the children's creations! As always, dressing up is optional as we recognise that for some children this can cause anxiety.

As a school, we will be finding out all about The Queen's Platinum Jubilee in our special whole school assembly, which will take place in school prior to 27th May. This special assembly will inform the children about the Queen's 70 years of service and be lead by Miss Elliott, History Lead.

An outline of our plans for 27th May include:

- A class art activity that will feed in to a whole school Platinum Jubilee Art Display
- The making of a flag and place setting
- A 'Street Party' style lunch with music which we hope to deliver outside on the KS2 playground
- Each class will be making a class Jubilee card which we will be posting off to the Queen!
- An ice pop for each child which will be provided by the Friends of BHPS

Children can either bring their own packed lunch for the Street Party or our caterers have designed a special lunch menu for the day, which is attached. In addition, the DfE has commissioned a special Platinum Jubilee book which every child in the country will receive a copy of. However we have been informed that these may not arrive in school until much later in the term.

We would like to thank the Friends of BHPS for funding this wonderful day for the school; providing such a memorable day would not have been possible without them.

We hope this will be a day full of fun and joy for all the children at BHPS and one that they will remember!
